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Light at the End of the COVID-19 Tunnel?

Leasing velocity will remain minimal at the beginning of 2021. However, once COVID-19 vaccines are distributed and companies begin to return to the office, the second half of 2021 should regain momentum.

The first half of 2021 is expected to have minimal leasing velocity, with many companies still evaluating what the future of their workspace will look like as they plan a return to the office following the broader distribution of COVID-19 vaccines. Optimistically, we are expecting increased transaction volume in the second half of the year as these companies look to implement their new real estate strategies. However, this will likely still result in increased vacancy, both on a direct and sublease basis, and negative absorption for calendar year 2021

Vacancy & Absorption

- » Office vacancy in the suburbs increased 200 basis points in the past year, rising to 24 percent at the end of 2020.
- » Class A vacancy also increased, rising to 25.2 percent, up 250 basis points from 2019.
- » There is currently 3.1 million square feet of sublease space available throughout the suburban office market with 1.5 million square feet currently vacant, an increase of 1.3 million square feet from year-end 2019.
- » Class A and B product both reported negative absorption at the end of 2020, reporting over 2 million square feet of negative net absorption.

Transaction Activity

- » Currently we are tracking 10 15% of "normal" leasing activity in the market.
- » Leasing activity was down 1.5 million square feet from year-end 2019.



2018 - 2020




- » Thirty-two new leases or lease expansions of 15,000 square feet or larger were signed throughout the suburbs during 2020 compared to the 43 that were signed in 2019.
- » Twelve suburban office sale transactions of 50,000 square feet or larger were completed in 2020, totaling 1.5 million square feet.


Forecast

- » Larger corporate users will become more active with longerterm decisions in the second half of 2021 after re-entering their existing offices and determining how to best utilize workspaces.
- » Flexibility and short-term lease commitments will continue to be a priority throughout 2021 with small and mid-size users.
- » Sublease activity will continue throughout 2021 as users look to shed excess office space and tenants take advantage of discounted pricing and furnished opportunities.
- » As we come out of the COVID caused recession, concessions will increase, and rental rates will decease as landlords aggressively pursue new tenants.
- » Investors and tenants will reevaluate whether they want to be in Cook County due to the uncertainty of real estate taxes.










Message from CREW Chicago's President

CREW Chicago is a chapter of CREW Network, a global organization that has more than 12,000 members in over 75 markets. Th ough CREW Chicago, you can access CREW Network's leadership development program, attend industry presentations on a wide range of subjects, and take advantage of business networking and volunteer opportunities. CREW Network is the leading provider of research on gender and diversity in commercial real estate. Go to their website at CREWNetwork.org, and you will find annual research papers as well as benchmark studies CREW Network has produced every five years since 2005 covering gender bias, the economic benefits of diversity and the continuing concern of pay parity.

For over 30 years, CREW Chicago has offered unmatched opportunities to network, learn and hone skills to advance and thrive in our industry. Our Programs committee offers programs on various industry topics. Women getting it done in commercial real estate By Matt Baker

s real estate still a man's world? From architecture to brokerage to property management and everything in between, women continue to make strides in CRE, occupying top roles throughout the fi ld.

That's not to say, however, that the experiences of women in commercial real estate are fully equitable or that we don't still have some progress to make. For that reason, REjournals recently gathered 14 women to speak at the 2nd annual Women in Real Estate Conference.

Lisa Davidson, vice chairman and chief diversity office at Savills, moderated the fi st discussion, which gathered Influential women in CRE. Joining her were Alba Colavitti, senior design associate at Lamar Johnson Collaborative; Helen Karlos, vice president, property management at Zeller; Dannielle Lewis, senior manager at Wipfli and Danielle Tillman, managing principal at bKL Architecture.

Looking back on how they might change things early on in their careers, the panelists agreed that they were perhaps more timid than their male peers. They said that they would have taken more chances early on and not worried about seeming naïve or inexperienced.

"You need to ask questions like there's no tomorrow," Colavitti said. "Jump in and

get out of your comfort zone. You can make mistakes, just don't make them too expensive."

Even though women make up a sizable portion of the CRE workforce, some men are still adjusting, especially when women are in authoritative roles. Tillman described an instance where the contractor on a site that she was project managing introduced her to his crew and stressed that she was in charge. While welcome, she knew that the same would not have to be done if she were a man.

LaVon Johns, partner at Quintairos, Prieto, Wood & Boyer, moderated the second panel discussion which focused on prop-



erty management. Joining her were Angela Aeschliman, CPM, CCIM, LEED AP ND, senior vice president property and asset management at The Missner Group; Jillian Brown, senior consultant, flex ble offic solutions at Avison Young; Nancy Roach, president at Strada Real Estate Services and Carrie Szarzynski, director of management services at NAI Hiffman.

When discussing property management, COVID-19 looms large at the moment. The panelists discussed the challenges they have faced during the pandemic, from communicating (often shifting) CDC guidelines to their tenants to strategizing long-term for when occupants begin to return.

Brown said that one strength that she and many other female property managers have relied on during this crisis is empathy. A trait that perhaps comes easier to women than to men, she said that it provided her the desire to understand what individuals and organizations were going through and therefore, what she can do to make their experience better.

According to Roach, the mettle of her leadership was tested by early upheavals during her career, but never more so than during the COVID-19 situation.

"I look at it not so much as a male versus female thing, but what kind of leader you are," Roach said. "Th's pandemic has separated the boys and girls from the men and the women."

The fi al panel gathered established leaders to discuss current workplace issues. Jessica Lingertat, managing partner at Gould & Ratner moderated the panel which featured Alissa Adler, senior vice president at Colliers International; Trish Kelly, president, corporate banking at TCF Bank and Kathryn Kovitz Arnold, partner and chair of the real estate condominiums groups at Taft Stettinius & Hollister.

Th s discussion also revolved around the pandemic and its impacts on commercial real estate. Adler discussed how offi users are kicking the can down the road as they wait to see how things shake out. Kelly discussed holding client meetings outdoors or on the golf course as a way to maintain face time with clients.

"People sometimes wrongly believe that women have a different approach to communication," Kelly said, "and not being in person they don't have body language to go off of. We have to use our words more carefully."
